➤ Applicant must be a Firm / Proprietary/ Company registered under Companies Act, with Valid Drug licenses for various categories of allopathic drugs issued by Drug Control Authority of the State under the provision of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 as applicable under any other law in force. The applicant must not have been convicted by the Drug Authorities and no case should be pending under Drugs and Cosmetic Act Rules. Copies of Drug licenses & form- 20, 21, 20 B, 21B (as applicable).

➤ In case of Proprietary firm, registration copy of the firm if any and GST Registration certificate/ In case of other firms-copy of the firm registration Certificate / In case of company-copy of certificate of incorporation issued by Registrar of companies and full address of registered office.

➤ Applicants should have minimum average annual turnover prescribed in above table during last 3 years ending on 31st March of last financial year ie, **31.03.2025**). Copy of the audited P&L Account and Balance Sheet duly Certified by the Chartered Accountant.

➤ Tenderers should have Shop / Office / Establishment in Tamilnadu Address Proof of the firm should be submitted.

➤ Photo ID proofs & PAN Number of Firm /Proprietor. Self attested Copy of Aadhar Card/Passport /other acceptable ID proofs of Individuals/Proprietor/ Partners / Directors of the firm in personal capacity is/are to be attached to the Technical Bid forms. 2. General Terms & Conditions:-

- a) The selection is valid for 1+1 years. After shortlisting of suppliers, based on the credentials submitted by them, price bids of only shortlisted bidders will be opened.
- b) Supply of medicines on monthly basis or as per Bank's requirement, as per the indent given by the Bank Medical Officer (BMO). The list of medicines generally required/being used by the Dispensary are appended here with in Annexure-B.
- c) The supplier has to supply the medicines as per the list indented by BMO. No substitution shall be allowed unless such substitute approved by BMO in written confirmation to the supplier.
- d) Orders shall be placed by the Bank to the H1 Tenderer (who quotes highest discount on MRP). The Discount quoted in financial bid shall be valid for the entire contract period.
- e) The Tenderers are expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the tender documents. Failure to furnish all information required as per the Tender Document or submission of bids not substantially responsive to the Tender Documents in every aspect will be at the Tenderer's risk and shall result in rejection of the Tenderer.
- f) The tenderers have to submit declaration form .Non submission will be treated as 'disqualified' for the e-tendering process.
- g) **Recently manufactured / latest batch of medicines only to be supplied.**
Medicines wherein expiry date is very near / expired not to be supplied.
- h) In case the medicines supplied by the Tenderer are found to be dubious or spurious, the Tenderer shall indemnify the Bank against all losses/claims that may be caused/lodged against the Bank on account of such defective medicines including the rights / damages available under the various laws of the land. Medicines not in good condition in any lot shall not be accepted by the Bank and are to be replaced.
- i) In case of any dispute the matter will be under the jurisdiction of Salem Courts.

3. Disclaimer:

The information contained in this Tender document or information provided subsequently to Tenderer(s) or applicants whether verbally or in documentary form by or on behalf of State Bank of India (Bank), is provided to the Tenderer(s) on the terms and conditions set out in this Tender document and all other terms and conditions subject to which such information is provided.

This Tender is neither an agreement nor an offer and is only an invitation by Bank to the interested parties for submission of bids. The purpose of this TENDER is to provide the Tenderer(s) with information to assist the formulation of their proposals. This TENDER does not claim to contain all the information each Tenderer may require. Each Tenderer should conduct its own investigation and analysis and should check the accuracy, reliability and completeness of the information in this TENDER and where necessary obtain independent advice. Bank makes no representation or

warranty and shall incur no liability under any law, statute, rules or regulations as to the accuracy, reliability or completeness of this TENDER. Bank may in its absolute discretion, but without being under any obligation to do so, add all amend or supplement the information in this TENDER. No contractual obligation whatsoever shall arise from the TENDER process until a formal contract is signed and executed by duly authorized officers of the Bank with the selected Tenderer.

The Bank reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid/ offer received in part or in full, and to cancel the bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract of award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Tenderer or Tenderers or any obligation to inform the affected Tenderer or Tenderers of the grounds for the Bank's action. Bank reserves the right to reject any Bid on security and / or other considerations without assigning any reason.

4. Bidding Document:

The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid. Bank will not be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

5. Content of Bidding Document

- The bidding document provides overview of the requirements, bidding procedures and contract terms. It includes instructions to Tenderer, Terms & Conditions of Contract, Eligibility Criteria for Technical Bid and Financial Bid.

The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, statements, terms and specifications in the bidding document. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or submission of bid not responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at the Tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the bid. SBI has made considerable effort to ensure that accurate information is contained in this TENDER and is supplied solely as guidelines for Tenderers. Furthermore, during the TENDER process, SBI is entitled to issue corrigendum to Tender relevant to the Scope of Work. Nothing in this TENDER or any addenda is intended to relieve Tenderers from forming their own opinions and conclusions in respect of the matters addressed in the TENDER or any addenda.

a) Clarifications & Amendments:

If deemed necessary, the Bank may seek clarifications on any aspect from the Tenderer. However, that would not entitle the Tenderer to change or cause any change in the substances of the bid already submitted or the price quoted. The Tenderer may be asked to give presentation for the purpose of clarification of the bid. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, SBI may modify or alter the bidding document by issuing an amendment.

Any clarification issued by SBI will be in the form of an addendum / corrigendum and will be available in SBI's website – <https://sbi.co.in> under "SBI in the news"- Procurement News or on <https://etender.sbi..> The amendment will be binding on all Tenderers.

6. Bidding Process:
Terms & conditions of e-tendering:

SBI shall finalize the Tender through e-tendering mode by engaging an authorized service provider. Please go through the guidelines given below and submit your acceptance to the same along with your Price Bid.

e-tendering shall be conducted by SBI through authorized service provider on pre- specified date. While the Contractors shall be quoting from their own offices/ place of their choice, Internet connectivity and other paraphernalia requirements shall have to be ensured by Contractors themselves. In the event of failure of their Internet connectivity, (due to any reason whatsoever it may be) it is the bidders' responsibility. The Bank will conduct the bidding through e-tendering and arrangements will be made through M/s.e-Procurement Technologies Ltd. who will be the authorized service provider for the same. e-Tendering among the bidders shall be conducted by State Bank of India through the service provider on pre-specified date, while the bidders shall be quoting from their offices / place of their choice. The eligible bidders shall be guided by our service provider, for taking part in the e-auction.

All details with the relevant information / documents / acceptance of all terms and conditions strictly as described in this tender document will have to be submitted.

The Tenderer should obtain encrypted digital signature for participating in e-tendering. All bidders have to use DSC as per their registered name on <https://etender.sbi/SBI/>. Bidder shall use valid Class II or Class III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) issued by competent Certifying Authority with signing and encryption key. If bidder registered as Pvt Ltd / Limited / Partnership firm, then DSC should as according to their company type only with the same name. If bidder registered as proprietary firm or individually then he/she may use individual type DSC.

In order to ward-off such contingent situation, bidders are requested to make all the necessary arrangements / alternatives such as back-up power supply etc. whatever required so that they are able to circumvent such situation and still be able to participate in the E-tendering successfully.

Failure of power at the premises of bidders during the E-tendering cannot be the cause for not participating in the E-tendering. Internet connectivity and other paraphernalia requirements shall have to be ensured by the bidders themselves. In the event of failure of their Internet connectivity (due to any reason whatsoever it may be) it is the bidder's responsibility. It is be noted that neither State Bank of India nor the authorized service provider are responsible for these unforeseen eventualities. On account of this, the time for the E-tendering will not be extended and SBI shall not be responsible for any such eventualities.

Authorized service provider shall arrange to train your nominated person(s), without

any cost to you. They shall also explain you all the Rules related to the E- tendering. You are required to give your compliance on it before start of bid process.

7. Financial / Price Bid:

After completion of evaluation process, the price bids of only shortlisted bidders shall be opened, wherein the bidders are allowed to offer discount percentage on MRP. Rates quoted are on FOR (Freight on Road) basis for agreed destinations and Bank will not pay any additional costs like freight, wages, loading / unloading, transportation, wastages, octroi, overheads, profit, incidental charges and all related expenses towards supply of Medicines. The rates and/or prices in any form or for any reasons should not be disclosed in the technical bid or other parts of the technical bid except in the Financial bid and failure to do so would result disqualification and rejection of the bid. These rates are valid throughout the year.

The Bidder shall quote their offers he will be willing to execute the work, in terms of **“Specific Percentage Numerical Value” (only upto two decimal places)**

8. Pre-Bid Meeting:

The Bank shall organize a pre-bid meeting as mentioned in the tender document.

9. Validity of Bids: **The Bid price shall be firm for a period specified in the tender document and shall not be subjected to any change whatsoever.** Within the validity period of the tender the Bank shall issue a letter of acceptance either directly by registered post or otherwise depositing at the address of the bidder as given in the tender to enter into a Contract for the execution of the work as per the terms of the tender. The letter of acceptance shall constitute a binding contract between the SBI and the supplier.

10. Bid Integrity:

Willful misrepresentation of any fact within the Bid will lead to the cancellation of the contract without prejudice to other actions that the Bank may take. All the bids with accompanying documents will become property of SBI.

11. Format and Signing of Bid

The Tenderer should prepare submission as per eligibility criteria, Technical Bid and other requested information.

All pages of the Bid document should be serially numbered and shall be signed by the authorized person(s) only. The person(s) signing the bid shall sign all pages of the bid and rubber stamp should be affixed on each page except for an un-amended printed literature. In case of Company, the Tenderer should submit a copy of board resolution or power of attorney showing that the signatory has been duly authorized to sign the tender document.

Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if the person(s) signing the bid sign(s) them in full.

12. Evaluation of Applications:

Evaluation of Applications will be done by a Committee comprising of Officers from State Bank of India based on the credentials submitted and after obtaining discrete feedback from the previous clients.

Opening and Evaluation of Bids:

1. Opening of Technical Bid: All the Bids will be opened at the date, time & locations mentioned in the NIT. Credentials / Eligibility criteria of the bids received shall be evaluated based on the criteria / conditions mentioned in the tender.

2. Evaluation of Bids: Financial bids will be considered for opening for those only who meet the eligibility criteria as specified in the tender and also supply of branded medicines as specified in the NIT

3. Thus price bids of all shortlisted bidders will be opened and the Order shall be placed by the Bank to the bidder **who quotes the highest discount (H1) on MRP**

4. In case, the highest discount (H1) amount quoted by two or more contractors is the same, such bidders ONLY will again be asked to submit sealed / online Offers, but the revised percentage shall, in no case, be more than the percentage quoted during their initial offer for the project. The H1 shall be decided on the basis of revised offers. The process of online rebidding/ sealed bid amongst the two or more contractors offering same rates shall continue till H1 bidder is discovered.

5. In case, any of such contractors or all contractors (who have quoted same tender amount in the initial bidding or subsequent bidding) refuse to submit revised offer, it shall be treated as "Withdrawal of tender" by the Contractor before acceptance by SBI and the EMD (if any) of such contractors shall be forfeited and they shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process for the work.

13. Award & Signing of contract:

SBI will notify successful Tenderer (H1 i.e. who quoted highest discount on MRP) in writing by letter in duplicate or fax that its bid has been accepted. The Selected Tenderers has to return the duplicate copy of the bank within 7 working days duly Accepted, Stamped and Signed by Authorized in token of acceptance

The successful Tenderer shall be required to enter into a contract with the Bank, within 7 days of the award of the tender or within such extended period as may be decided by the Bank along with the letter of acceptance.

Period of Contract:

The contract is valid for 1+1 years and the rate contract period of the contract is 1 (One) year.

14. Payment Terms:

Upon supply of entire medicines by the highest discount (H1) Tenderer, payment will be released by the respective AO/RBO against submission of GST invoice and satisfactory certificate issued by the Bank Medical Officer to this effect, after effecting statutory deductions as applicable.

Payment shall be made by way credit the Account / Electronic Fund Transfer (RTGS/NEFT) mode and H1 Tenderer should furnish details of the Bank A/c No., IFSC code or SBI account on the invoices.

No Interim / Advance payment shall be made by the Bank.

15. Termination of the Contract

The Bank reserves the right to terminate the agreement in case of breach of any terms and conditions of this agreement by the successful tenderer with one month notice. The Bank also reserves its right, to claim damages for such breaches and the decision of the bank in this regard shall be final. Bank can terminate the agreement if the services provided by the successful tenderer are found to be unsatisfactory. Delivery of the services and performance of the services shall be made by the successful tenderer in accordance with the time schedule and other terms and conditions as specified in the TENDER.

16. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for delay in performing obligations if the delay or failure is due to any of the following force majeure i.e. Act of God or any Government Act, fire, earthquake, explosion, strikes/ Bandh, civil commotion or anything beyond the control of either party. The party shall make all reasonable endeavors to minimize any such delay.

17. Governing Language

The contract and all correspondence / communications and other documents pertaining to the Contract, shall be written in English.

18. Eligible Taxes:

- a) Income Tax if applicable will be deducted at source as per Govt. guidelines.
- b) GST component will be paid only on submission of proper GST invoice as per applicable GST provisions. The successful tenderer should comply with the following:
 - i) Successful tenderer should have GST Registration Number
 - ii) Successful tenderer should timely file GST returns in accordance with GST provisions to enable the bank to claim the input credit of GST paid to the supplier.

19. Place of Delivery: As specified above in all six dispensaries of SBI at Salem and Pondicherry on FOR (Freight on Road) basis. SBI may add / alter the delivery locations within Salem Module and no extra charges for transportation shall be claimed.

20. Indemnity: The tenderer shall indemnify and hold the Bank, its officers, officials and employees harmless against any and all action, suits, claims damages, or demands brought or made against the Bank arising out of or in connection with the performance of the agreement or in respect of anything done or committed to be done by the tenderer in execution of or in connection with the supply of medicines/drugs/consumables & against any loss or damage to the Bank in consequence to any action or suit being brought against the tenderer for anything done or committed to be done in the execution of this contract.

21. Settlement of Dispute and Arbitration: All questions relating to the performance of the obligations under this Contract/Agreement and to the quality and genuineness of the drugs and consumables supplied/used in respect of the services and all the disputes and differences which shall arise either during or after the agreement period or other matters arising out of or relating to this agreement or payment to be made in pursuance thereof shall be referred to The Deputy General Manager (B&O), State Bank of India, Administrative Office, Salem, whose decision shall be final, conclusive and binding on the contractor.
